**Test Update –  
BETA 2 MICROGLOBULIN and KAPPA-LAMBDA  
FREE LIGHT CHAIN**

As of January 13, 2009, any serum beta-2-microglobulin (B2M) or kappa-lambda free light chain (KAPP/LAM F) order that is placed within 24 hours of a prior B2M or KAPP/LAM F will be considered a duplicate order and automatically cancelled. Due to the half-life of serum proteins, meaningful changes in B2M and KAPP/LAM results are unlikely to occur in less than 24 hours.
