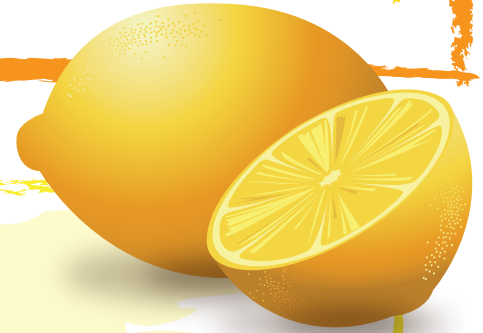


LEMONADE TOUR

Help your children understand what is involved in healing your cancer by bringing them on a Lemonade Tour at the University of Colorado Cancer Center. Each 45- to 60-minute tour is completely tailored to the age and needs of your child and is led by a health care professional trained in promoting family health.

Your children will tour the cancer center and have the opportunity to ask questions about your treatment. Younger children can explore the playroom, read stories and watch videos that help them cope with having a parent with cancer. Older children can use computers and resource rooms to research and learn about how they can help their family learn to live with cancer.

Parents and caregivers also benefit from the tour, as they observe and discuss with their tour guide how to communicate with their children about cancer.

Lemonade Tours are free and available for children and adolescents up to 18 years old who are accompanied by parents, grandparents or caregivers. And, of course, no Lemonade Tour would be complete without cookies and lemonade.
